



EXPECTATIONS FOR FIELD TRIP GROUPS

- Students must be accompanied by an adult chaperone at all times. Each adult chaperone must have an assigned small group of 6-8 students (K-12) or 4-5 students (Pre-K). Please ensure that a chaperone and their small group of students stay together during the entire field trip.
- Ensure that all chaperones and students have a name tag with their first name and small group designation.
- Chaperones must support the educator leading the tour/program by modeling proper behavior and addressing discipline issues.
- Students must use “inside voices” in the Museum – no shouting.
- Absolutely no running in the Museum.
- Absolutely no food or drinks in the Galleries.
- Absolutely no touching any artifacts or clear display cases, unless invited to do so by Museum staff.
- There are some interactive displays in the Galleries: touchscreens, wheels to turn, buttons to press, and drawers to open. Use these with care and follow any instructions listed on the display or given by Museum staff.
- Photographs may be taken in the permanent Museum Galleries, but absolutely no photographs of Native American artifacts in Gallery 1.
- Chaperones must accompany and supervise students in all areas of the Museum including Museum Galleries, outdoor areas, foyers, gift shop, and bathrooms.
