



FIELD TRIPS TO THE REACH

Field trips groups are welcome at the REACH Museum! Your students can encounter a baby woolly mammoth, dozens of species of plants and animals, 17 million-year-old basalt, camels and rhinoceros from the Tri-Cities, and one of the most significant and innovative scientific projects in history!



We have developed two kinds of experiences for your students: guided and self-guided. Guided field trips include an educational program from Courses and Tributaries, along with time to explore the museum. An education staff member will remain with your group for the entirety of your visit. Self-guided field trips are for when you want to lead your own tour of the museum with your own activities. Paper-based scavenger hunts are available upon request.

Admission cost for K-12 guided field trips is \$7 per student. Self-guided field trips are \$5 per student. Teachers with their classes are free as are adult chaperones at a ratio of 1 adult per 7 students. Additional chaperones will be charged the group rate (\$7 for adults; \$5 for seniors 65+)

[Note for homeschool groups: the cost for all children (excluding infants) is \$7/\$5 per child. If paying per family, the cost is \$5 per adult. The 1:7 ratio discount only applies to a single group payment.]

Admission cost for Pre-K guided field trips is \$4 per child (excluding infants). Teachers with their class are free, and chaperones are free at a ratio of 1 adult per 5 children. Additional chaperones will be charged a discounted price of \$5 per adult.

Maximum number of students is 120 for a self-guided field trip.

Maximum number of students for an educator-led program is 60 students.
